Selecting courses for the first semester is an important step in your academic journey. As an international student, you may become eligible to be advised by an academic advisor and register for courses early if you do the following:

- Register for the self-paced online algebra tutorial program, MATH 008, and complete all the exercises. Regardless of your math preparation to date, this online course is **mandatory** in order to take MATH 108 which is required for all School of Business majors. You can sign up for MATH 008 (CRN 81685) using patriotweb.gmu.edu. Guidance on how to use patriot web can be found here. You should add only MATH 008 (CRN 81685) at this time.
- 2. MATH 008 can be completed in as little as 2 weeks. As soon as you complete the online course, send your name, G#, and a brief message indicating you have completed MATH 008 to the course coordinator via email: gbulance@gmu.edu. Completing this requirement promptly will facilitate advising and scheduling courses prior to orientation.
- 3. You will be guided in your fall course selection prior to orientation if you complete MATH 008 prior to August 1. Your academic advisor will contact you about your fall semester course schedule.
- 4. Attend orientation on August 21, 2018.
