Change to F1 Status IN US

Pay the I-901 SEVIS Fee https://fmjfee.com/

Work with your attorney to file your change to F1 status and any bridge applications to USCIS. Keep OIPS informed of updates.

Submit USCIS I-797 Notice of Receipt of your Change to F1 Status Application by

- Remain in the US while application is pending.
- Submit your I-797 approval notice to oipsregs@gmu.edu within 3 days of receipt.

CHANGE TO F1 STATUS BY TRAVEL

Pay the I-901 SEVIS Fee https://fmjfee.com/

Schedule a visa interview at a US Consulate.

- Note: If you already have a change of status application filed with USCIS, you must contact USCIS to withdraw your application.
- Enter the US no earlier than 30 days from the start date on your I-20.

Once your change of status to F1 has been approved, to activate your F1 status you must:
